



Cable Hanger Instructions

Compatibility

Our cable hanger is compatible with most seatpost collars (integrated and non-integrated) that utilize a 5mm, 6mm, or 8mm bolt (or quick-release skewer) to clamp the seatpost into a frame with a rear-facing seat tube slot.

Intended Use

The Surly Cable Hanger provides a stop for the brake housing that ends above your rear traditional (not linear-pull) cantilever brake. Our hanger may address fit issues on smaller frames and frames with unique cable routing.

Tools Required

- Grease
- Adhesive tape
- Hex wrench (fitting your seatpost collar bolt)
- Torque wrench

Installation

1. Using tape, mark your seatpost where it lines up with the top of the seatpost collar.
2. Remove the bolt (or quick-release skewer) from the seatpost collar, and remove the seatpost from the frame.
3. Insert the loop portion of the cable hanger into the collar slot.
4. Grease the threads of the collar bolt and reinstall it, with the bolt penetrating the cable hanger loop.
5. Grease the seatpost, insert it into the frame...down to your tape mark, and tighten the collar bolt to the manufacturer's recommended torque specification.
6. Make sure that the loop of the cable hanger does not interfere with the function of the seatpost, frame, collar, or collar bolt.
